INTRODUCTION

This short publication was made for two reasons. First, to provide a simple way to help people understand a bit more precisely what is defined by RDA, AACR2, MARC format, and so on. In this way, when someone says that MARC, or AACR2, or ISBD should change, they will have a better idea of what each term does and does not pertain to. One record has been chosen at random and analysed in various ways.

This publication is far from complete and does not pretend to teach anything, it only demonstrates. When someone talks about, e.g. MARC, all the reader needs to do is look at the colored areas to get an idea of what that means.

The second reason for this publication is for me to learn a bit more about how to make ebooks.

To create the content, I used [MarcEdit](#) and the [BIBFRAME website](#). To create the actual book, I used [LibreOffice](#), [Calibre](#) and [Sigil](#). The image for the title page was made using [Paint.net](#).

ISO2709 version of the RDA record

This is what is actually exchanged when a record in one library catalog is downloaded into another library catalog. The main entry and primary title (100 |a and 245 |a) are highlighted. The "MARC format" examples we saw earlier were generated in some way from this type of file.

The string of numbers at the beginning provides the structure for the rest of the record. This structure has been adapted for many different forms of MARC, e.g. UNIMARC, RUSSMARC and so on.

BIBFRAME version of the MARCXML record

Once we get away from ISO2709, many formats become possible. The big discussion now is about BIBFRAME.

This example uses a preliminary version of BIBFRAME. It was created from the MARCXML record. Note all the links (<http://>) throughout the record that are not seen in the previous formats.

This is an example of **linked data**.

The main entry and title are **highlighted**. I have also implemented the link for the author's name. This information appears in various places and the structure is quite different from what we have seen before.

There are also no longer 100 |a and 245 |b. These have been replaced by
